2. Agenda items included:

- Interim traffic guidelines to include cell phone usage while driving

3. Army/Air Guard LPC *Interim Vehicle Traffic Recommendations*:

3.1 Vehicles have the right of way on all installation roadways:

Runners/walkers will maintain single file formation on all roadways

Reference: 121ARWI 91-207, paragraph 4.1

Runners/walkers will use reflective gear from sunset to sunrise, but it is highly recommended that runners and walkers avoid periods of darkness

Reference: AFOSH STD 91-501, Paragraph 14.6

If running/walking on the flight line access road (south of the hangars) be aware of the red line designating the priority area where the aircraft are parked. This red line may not be crossed.

Reference: 121ARWI 91-207, paragraph 4.1

3.2 All state traffic and speed regulations apply on this installation.

Reference: Ohio Revised Code

3.3 Vehicle operators on this installation and operators of Government owned vehicles are *highly recommended* to not use cell phones unless the vehicle is parked or unless drivers are using hands-free devices.

Reference AR 190-5

3.4 Cell phones will not be used when approaching, passing through, or exiting base entry/exit points.

4. Pending concurrence of wing commander, these recommendations will remain in effect until state ONG legal opinion states otherwise.

5. These recommendations will be distributed to 121 ARW Commander B Gen Tom Botchie requesting base wide distribution, Army LPC Union Rep Clint Byington & Army LPC Management Rep Andy Morrow, and Mr. Dean Boling.

6. Request will also be made by both Army and Air LPC Co-Chairs to Mr. Dean Boling for an expedited legal review of scope and applicability of pertinent traffic regulations.
