2. Agenda items included:

- Update on Interim Traffic Guidelines
- Labor-Management Training
- Labor Partnership Website
- LPC Representatives from Operations Group
- Update on Medical Retirement Information

3. Interim Traffic Guidelines:

- 3.1 Col Boling reported that he had received a determination from the JAG regarding the traffic guidelines. The JAG's focus was primarily on the DoDI and AFI on installation sovereignty. The bottom line is for the two parties to come up with guidelines they can agree to and make it policy. The TAG wants this to be a collective effort by both the Army and Air. Rickenbacker has been working on a policy for some time, but has not implemented it. The guidelines set out by the LPC along with the draft policy will be a start in that direction. Col Boling recommended using the LPC guidelines as an interim policy until a new policy is approved. It was noted that the guidelines outlined in the 11 October 06 minutes had been approved by both Army and Air sides and that BGen Botchie has encouraged expanding on these guidelines to come up with a permanent policy. LPC representatives at the December meeting of the Army LPC will be Greg Shafer and Mike Troxel. Item closed until further review of the draft regulation.

3.2 Policy discussion items:

3.2.1 Policy must focus on the safety and well-being of members.

3.2.1.1 Obey all traffic laws.

3.2.1.2 Determine right of way for slow moving vehicles and alert vehicles.

3.2.1.3 Determine guidelines for runners and formations. Wearing of headphones while running.

3.2.2 Who adjudicates if a law is broken?

3.2.2.1 Point system for offenses is a possible approach. Considering possible suspension of driving privileges on base for repeat offenders.

3.2.2.2 Jurisdiction on traffic and safety. The sheriff and municipal do not have jurisdiction on the installation.

3.2.3 Parking. In designated areas only.

3.2.3.1 RV and boat parking. We often see RVs and boats taking up valuable parking spaces. Note: Col Boling is looking for an acceptable parking area.

3.2.4 Abandoned vehicles. They are a security risk. Will be towed. Signs should be posted.

3.2.5 Seat belt use while driving on base and cell phone use in vehicles.

4. Labor Management Training: Item tabled until next the next meeting. An agenda of the Ohio National Guard Labor-Management Training course was made available.

5. Labor Partnership Website: The state is working on the website and it should be up and running by 9 November. Lt Roche has asked to post our LPC minutes on the site. LPC agreed with the understanding the minutes would be reviewed for sensitive information. LPC also recommended posting the Technician and AGR handbooks.

6. Selecting LPC Representative from Operations Group: Bill Alford is still working the issue.

7. Medical Retirement Information: Item tabled until next meeting. Information has been posted on the Wing Bulletin Board.

8. Change in LPC Meeting Schedule: A recommendation was made to change the meeting schedule to quarterly to coincide with PEC schedule. LPC would like to keep meetings on a monthly schedule as they can be cancelled if there are no pressing issues.
