4. Old Business

A. IBB Work Schedule – Reagan

When do we want to meet to start the IBB? Can't do the week of the 18th thru 22nd (holiday on 18th). Have to do 8 hour day Mon-Fri. Just need quorum to hold it but hopefully entire committee will be there for whole process. Need to hold it somewhere on base besides Commander's Conference Room and will have to have refreshments – take up a collection.

B. Energy Update - Giezie

Heat demand was down by 15%. Cooling demand was up by 93% because we had a warm October – but we didn't use much air. Nat'l gas use down by 10.8% on consumption. Utility budget – projecting that we saved \$31,340 if we stay the same – should meet Governor's goals (primarily because for 2 ½ months we did not have heat in the hangar).

1. New Business

A. Partnership Recorder – Reagan

If we know anyone who can be able to augment the recorder – please forward their names. Maybe have a lead recorder with augmentees. Leimenstoll said we could always send out a base-wide email for volunteers; however, it was decided to have Group Commanders provides names and set a possibly set a schedule. Reagan would contact the other Commanders for names.

B. Jan 17 – LPC has to attend meeting down at Columbus along with 2nd level management – meeting between management and labor with TAG. From 0800 hrs to 1300hrs. Reagan sent out an email to management who had to attend. Masiker said they have a 44 passenger bus that will take people down but he has to have a list of names. Bus will leave @ 0530hrs. Col August had a spreadsheet for signing up for the bus.
