PARTNERSHIP MEETING MINUTES

MEETING began at 1330 on 26 May 2010: attendees were Michael Smith, Paul Tumidolsky (recorder), Dave McDarmont, Bobby Lykins, Josh Bell, Doug Schmitt, and Edward Jenkins.

1. OLD BUSINESS:

a. Running Track – CLOSED

The running track has been funded and will be built. No further action needed.

b. Repainting floor/yellow stripes – CLOSED

Yellow “taxi stripes” outside the hangar doors have been painted. A striping machine was ordered and Ed Jenkins and Doug Schmitt repainted the lines.

c. Sealing the Ramp – OPEN

On 7 May, BG (ret) Lee and others from the DIMR toured the ramp and noted years of damage and decay. The facility priority of work was given as 1) weed eradication, 2) repaving/repainting of the ramp, and 3) repainting of the hangar floor, walls, and ceiling.

d. Workout Equipment – OPEN

Equipment from 73rd Troop Command will be transferred in June. This will be closed upon transfer and local purchase of workout equipment.

e. Electric Cables in the Hangar – CLOSED

Cables were installed in late April and early May. No further action needed.

f. Hangar Doors – CLOSED

Doors have been fixed. No further action needed.

g. Job Announcements – OPEN

A committee was formed to study and make recommendations based upon open positions in the facility. The recommendations have labor approval and will be presented to COL Driesbach. The open FI has been hired and the WG-12 floor mechanic (three positions) will have interviews complete by 28 May 2010. Priorities for new positions are an additional FI, a TACOPS Officer, and a position to be determined.

j. Position Descriptions – OPEN


MAJ Smith is going to call the Indiana Guard to inquire about a TACOPS PD. Per HRO; any PD can not be changed without OPM approval.
