SUBJECT: LPC MINUTES

1. The purpose of this memorandum is to distribute the meeting minutes from the LPC held at Rickenbacker Flight Facility on 21 Sep. 2006
2. The following personnel were in attendance: MSG Gheen, WO2 Scott, MSG Lidke from Management and SFC Scherer, SFC Ribacchi, SGT. Jones from Labor. Visiting guests were LT. Hoogendoorn and Mike Brill. A quorum was present.
3. Minutes from the 13 JUL 2006 meeting were reviewed and accepted. Discussion from the last meeting included that the LPC needs to send out the Principles of Partnership to all facilities within the state so that Labor and Management would better understand the purpose and goals of the labor management partnership. Also we discussed the use of RCAS computers and the availability of these computers in each shop. MSG Lidke will check with Surface Maintenance if there could be a dedicated computer in each shop for employee's to use so that the main work stations would not be tied up. Shop Supervisors would arrange times during the day for these work stations to be used by the employee's. SFC Ribacchi or MSG Lidke will contact LT. Roche to get a copy of the ARMY PEC CHARTER.

New discussion was the LPC feels that representatives from Labor and Management need to set up a schedule to go out to our facilities together and explain the purpose of the partnership and importance thereof. MSG Lidke and SFC Scherer will contact Surface Maintenance and Union President for feasibility. The LPC also feels that when students of the IBB training have completed their training they should receive a completion certificate and or a list be posted so that Labor and Management would know who has taken the training. Also the LPC will draft a letter requesting a list of dues paying members. Mr Scott and SFC Ribacchi will contact LT. Roche for a list of students that have taken the IBB training and a list of dues paying members.
5. The LPC agreed to substitute WOC Cully Canan until MSG Roeth returns from deployment. With LPC members starting to return from deployment it was suggested to have the East and West regional meetings on the same day, same facility so both regions would be working in the same direction for the betterment of our members.
6. Next meeting will be 18 JAN 2007.
