Buckeye Inn housing policy

Members requesting clarification of the geographic area required to stay at the Buckeye inn or Camp Perry lodging.

Answer per the USPFO travelers claim guide dated 21 July 2005:

Temporary Duty to Camp Perry/RANGB - Lodging Restrictions

Travelers who are in IDT/AT/ADSW or civilian status with a rank of COL and below require non-availability statements if CPTS/RANGB quarters are not available (CPTS/RANGB (Buckeye Inn) quarters are adequate for such duty). If a non-availability statement has been issued, then the individual may occupy state housing (motels and cottages) or off-post housing. Travelers ordered to Ottawa County must use the CPTS lodging if available, travelers ordered to Franklin County must use the Buckeye Inn if available.

Serve weather procedure tri-fold:

Excellent document to clarify severe weather procedures for employees. Requesting clarification of who is considered an essential employee. Shop supervisors have already been deemed essential. What guidelines do we as supervisors use to determine who is essential for our employees? What documentation can we as FTUS personnel carry to validate this if stop by law enforcement? Agreement with the State Highway patrol, a state issued card by name like EMT's are issued.

Tracking of Safety counsel minutes:

The CBA (Collective Bargaining Agreement) dictates the tracking of these minutes by the LPC.

Labor meeting with FMS #6 employees


Labor LPC members and the employees of FMS#6 had a 20-30 minute meet and greet meeting to explain the role of the LPC.
